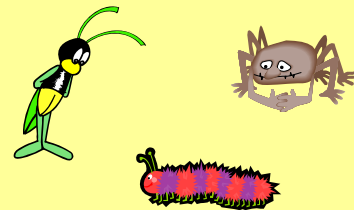
Saturday, June 25th
