they would be erected in. Cllr Wilkins said that the trees would be delivered on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December at 11.30am at Robartes Terrace and then to the New Inn. Cllr Wilkins, Mrs Heyes, Mr Dolling and two employees from Trevenson Garden Centre would help erect the trees. The lights and top decorations would be erected when the trees were delivered. The lower decorations would be placed on the trees on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2012 by Cllr Wilkins and Mrs Wilkins.

Cllr Wilkins said that he had been notified that the Robartes Inn would close on the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2012. He was contacting the purchaser to ask if they would be able to power the lights after the closure of the inn. If they were unable to power the lights or the sound system for the switch on Cllr Willkins would ask the Co-Op or a neighbouring property if they would be able to power the lights. He would consult an electrician regarding the length of cable and would ensure that the cable was secured safely.
