Cllr Mayne said that the surface of several paths in the parish were very wet and muddy. He felt that the council should set a budget to resurface some paths annually. Cllr Ford felt that signage should be displayed so that the public know that this Council was maintaining the paths.

Cllr Benney asked Cllr Wilkins to investigate with Cornwall Council the responsibility for the path that continued from Devonshire House.

It was proposed by Cllr Ford, seconded by Cllr Benney and

PM12/09/11.2 RESOLVED that the verbal report from the Clerk is received and that footpath maintenance is closely monitored by the Clerk and monthly reports are brought to this meeting.

On a vote being taken the matter was approved unanimously.

Cllr Benney said that he was concerned for people's safety on the paths and new roadways by Gwel an Mor. Cllr Wilkins agreed to discuss the issues with Cornwall Council.

The planning protocol seemed to cut out local councils that have knowledge of the local area. The planning system is too closed to parish and town councils and members of the public.

Cllr Benney left the meeting at 8.20pm.

Notwithstanding that the annexe is not connected to the main building it is tantamount to a new residence in an area where one would not normally be allowed due to lack of amenity space, over development of the site and it compounds an un-neighbourly development.
