Members discussed the short and long term plans for the park and phasing the project and timescales and funding involved; potential layouts for the park including parking, built facilities and access. Members did not want there to be any dark or secluded areas in the park. It was important that the park would be used as a community facility.

It was agreed that members would like the following items in the Park:

- Changing rooms x 4;
- Car Park;
- Multi sports pitch;
- Play area;
- Low maintenance gardens;
- Picnic area; and
- Seating.

The building should be in keeping with the surrounding area; single storey with:

- Changing rooms;
- Public area/viewing area/meeting room;
- · Parish Council office; and

Kitchen facilities.

The use of the building should be as flexible as possible and should be accessible to disabled persons.

It was further agreed that once appointed the architect should be invited to a meeting of this Working Group at the Park to enable members to discuss and communicate the design ideas and requirements from the park.
