IEAG12/04/5 TO RECEIVE THE RECOMMENDATION FROM THE GARDENING WORKING PARTY ON THE VIABILITY OF THE COMPETITION AND AGREE FUTURE ACTION

The Locum Clerk said that the Gardening Working Party had resolved to recommend to the Full Council that the gardening competition was held. There would be articles in the Illogan Review and West Briton and another poster displayed in the notice boards. The deadline for entries would be the 30th June 2012.

IEAG12/04/6 TO DISCUSS RECOMMENDATIONS TO FULL COUNCIL FOR EVENTS TO BE HELD IN 2012

It was agreed to recommend to Full Council that:

- 1. A Party in the Park is held adjacent to the Football Ground on Sunday 3rd June 2012 from 2pm until 5pm
- 2. Families are encouraged to bring their own picnic
- 3. The Royal British Legion will erect their charity stall outside of their clubhouse
- 4. There will be a red, white and blue theme with children being encouraged to wear a homemade crown, tiara or hat
- 5. There will be a bouncy castle for the children
- 6. Illogan Sparnon Silver Band will be approached and asked to play during the event
- 7. 200-300 saffron buns will be purchased
- 8. The fire brigade will be invited and it is hoped that they would be able to bring an engine
- Mr Dolling would ask Mr Easter to design a certificate to be presented to the winner of the school poster competition, Councillor Wilkins would donate a small prize
- 10. The hire of a PA System would be looked into
- 11. St Johns Ambulance would be on site
- 12. An arena would be roped off for team activities such as a tug of war, obstacle course, toddler race, space hopper race
- 13. Councillors Ford and Wilkins would sit and have wet sponges thrown at them
- 14. There would be an appeal in the media for space hoppers
- 15. All groups in the parish would be formally invited to attend
- 16. The Junior Football Club are going to hold a 'beat the goalie' and a dribble competition

It was also recommended that the Council purchase 1,000 envelopes and Queen's Diamond Jubilee stamps and to organise for them to be franked with Illogan and sealed in a cellophane cover to be given to all of the children in the parish during the Party in the Park.
