Deputy Chief Fire Officer Paul Walker provided the Committee with an update on Cornwall Fire and Rescue Service's plans for a new Camborne, Pool and Redruth Community Fire Station and Service Headquarters to be located at Boswithian Road, Tolvaddon. These plans were part of the service's Camborne, Pool, Redruth and Hayle Emergency Cover programme, designed to deliver service improvement; revenue efficiency savings and to provide modern, fit for purpose facilities. He explained that the service was currently meeting with local communities to view the plans and ensure these facilities were right for the communities they would be serving. DCFO Walker presented the plans for the Committee's comments and questions.
