They were concerned with the ongoing storm water and sewerage problems being experienced in the area. The water run-off would get worse if houses and roads were built. The entrance onto Bassett Road was dangerous as cars travelled fast along that stretch of road and there would be limited visibility from the entrance. There were also concerns about light pollution. Bats were seen in the area every evening and they wondered whether the bats were roosting on some of the old buildings on the site.

Cllr Holmes said that there had been two people killed in accidents on that stretch of raod. The Post Office had had to move the post box as it was too dangerous to use.
