Working at Height Policy

Working at height remains one of the biggest causes of fatalities and major injuries. Common cases include falls from ladders and through fragile roofs. Work at height means work in any place, including at or below ground level, where a person could fall a distance liable to cause injury.

Illogan Parish Council's employees are not expected to work at height in the course of their work at the present time. If this changes the Council will review this policy immediately.

Illogan Parish Council appoints contractors who may have to work at height. The Council will ensure that all contractors have suitable and sufficient procedures and safeguards in place to protect themselves, their employees and members of the public.
