Page 995 – Minute PM19/10/7.2 – in response to a question the Clerk and Cllr Ekinsmyth said that to date none of the requested surveys for Tehidy Mill Farm had been received. Cllr Ekinsmyth said that he would discuss the matter with the Cornwall Council Planning Officer.

Page 999 – Minute PM19/10/21.2 – Cllr Mrs Ferrett reported that she had attended the Cornwall Council Planning Committee meeting and spoke on

behalf of this Council about the planning application for Wenappa. Cornwall Cllr Ekinsmyth had also fully spoken about the application. The application was approved by the Cornwall Council Planning Committee with 9 votes for, 3 votes against and 1 abstention; 2 of the Cllrs that voted against the motion had attended the previously held site visit. The Illogan Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan had assisted with the decision as the site fell within the settlement boundary. It was suggested that the settlement boundary was closely scrutinised when the Illogan Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan was reviewed and that the boundary was amended if necessary. Cllr Ford reported that he had been looking at the conditions applied to the approval and he spoke to the following condition about drainage:

"The development hereby permitted shall not commence until the installation of a system for the disposal of surface water on the site has been completed in accordance with the details which shall first have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The details shall include a programme for maintaining the system. The system shall be retained and maintained thereafter in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To avoid flooding and in the interests of water quality and the residential amenities of future and neighbouring occupiers; in accordance with the aims and intentions of policies 13 and 26 in the Cornwall Local Plan Strategic Policies 2010 - 2030. A pre-commencement condition is necessary to ensure that adequate drainage provisions are built into the scheme from the offset."

Privately owned land so the Indian owner should be responsible and carry out repairs. As it is a highways civil offence to allow material to be washed onto the highway (mud/ grit / etc).'

 'There was mention that Illogan Parish Council had purchased two devices for recording speed of traffic we could do with such a device along Paynters lane as we experience problems during school runs and rush hours and boy racers accelerating hard up from the junction past the shops showing off. A very congested street. Having identified there is a speeding problem in recent canvasing by the councillors involved is the Parish council legally obliged to solve the problem is case of a fatality and follow up legal case by relatives etc'
