

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Report by Illogan Parish Council 2022/2023

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 121B sets out that Town and Parish Councils must prepare a report for any financial year ("the reported year") in which it receives Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) receipts.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Receipts

The total Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) receipts for the reported year are £24,922.21.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Expenditure

The total Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) expenditure for the reported year is £71,700.92.

Summary details of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) expenditure during the reported year

£71,700.92 expenditure was towards the provision of a perimeter path in Illogan Park. The perimeter path has increased the usage and inclusivity of the park allowing disabled wheelchair users and persons with pram and pushchairs greater access to enjoy the Park.
