Manningham Wood, near the Acorn Seat (specific location between existing pathways)

Project Overview

Illogan Parish Council invites qualified contractors to submit quotes for the provision of tarmacking works on a designated section between existing pathways in Manningham Wood, adjacent to the Acorn Seat. The work aims to improve accessibility and surface quality in this well-used area of the woodland.

Scope of Work

The successful contractor will be required to:

- Supply and lay suitable tarmac to the defined section between the two existing paths near the Acorn Seat.
- Carry out appropriate site preparation including surface levelling, cleaning, and edging.
- Ensure proper drainage where applicable to avoid surface water accumulation.
- Minimise disruption to public access and preserve surrounding woodland.
- Comply with all local environmental and safety regulations.

Submission Requirements

Interested contractors should submit the following:

1. A detailed proposal outlining the methods, equipment, and techniques to be used.
2. Proposed schedule and timeline.
3. Cost estimate, including a breakdown of all expenses.
4. References from previous clients for similar services.
5. Certification of insurance and worker's compensation.
