**FR25/11/5.2 RESOLVED** that the minutes of the meetings of the Finance and Resources Committee held on the 8<sup>th</sup> October 2025 are received and approved and signed by the Chairman.

**FR25/11/7 TO RECEIVE THE 2<sup>ND</sup> DRAFT BUDGET FOR THE 2026/2027 FINANCIAL YEAR AND MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO FULL COUNCIL**

Members thanked the Clerk for all the work she had put into the budget preparations, including obtaining indicative quotes and providing full explanations of the figures.

Cost code 201, General Grants – request that the Governance Review Committee review the Grant Policy with a view to increasing the maximum grant limit due to the cost increases.

The Clerk reported that she had received indicative costings to supply and install the additional MSAS posts and had amended the budget accordingly.

Members discussed the forecasts and budgets in detail.

It was proposed by Cllr Crabtree, seconded by Cllr Miss J Simmons and:

**FR25/11/7.2 RESOLVED** that the 2026/2027 budget for cost code 201 – General Grants is increased to £2,500. That the Clerk would create a new cost code for S106 income and move the S106 income from cost code 806 - Other Receipts. To delete cost codes

**807 – CTS Grant and 25 – Consultations. To recommend to Full Council a 2026/2027 budget of £378,288 and a precept of £235,219.**

On a vote being taken the matter was approved unanimously.

**FR25/11/8 TO REVIEW THE ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION TO THE MINING VILLAGES REGENERATION GROUP FOR INCLUSION ON CORNWALLTRAILS.NET AND AGREE ANY FUTURE ACTIONS**

It was proposed by Cllr Cullimore, seconded by Cllr Miss J Simmons and:

**FR25/11/8.2 RESOLVED that Illogan Parish Council cease their subscription to the Mining Villages Regeneration Group for inclusion on Cornwalltrails.net and that the trails are uploaded to the Illogan Parish Council website.**

On a vote being taken the matter was approved unanimously.
